- The biggest change is that the school year will have five (5) classes instead of six (6).
 Each period will be 65 minutes long with a 5 minute transition time.
- The school day will remain from 8:30 to 3:20
- We should have news from the district Mid July whether or not we will be on campus or will be using a hybrid model.
- Lunch will still be 50 minutes long, but will start at 1:10pm
- There will no longer be a "drop" period for college students, but instructors are creating ways to insure students have independent study time during structured study periods in class.
- Bard will continue to use the Passport Model when we are back on campus.
- The Learning Commons will now be another computer lab for classes to use.
- Grades 9 and 10 will have English, Math, and History as a year long class and all other subjects will be semester long
- Y1 and Y2 will have Seminar as a year long class and all other subject matter will be semester long.
- We have new faculty for Sy20/21. I for Chinese, 1 for Math, 2 for English, 1 for Physics, 1 for Chemistry
